Anne Fitzgerald Clancy, age 80, passed away April 1, 2021. She was born September 1, 1940 in Huntsville to Cecil and Dorothy Fitzgerald of Riverside.

Anne attended Huntsville High School, graduating in 1958. Majoring in Library Science, she graduated from then Sam Houston State Teachers College in 1961, later earning a master's degree from Texas Women's University.
