

Marion C. Coody 1935-2023

We are sad to announce that one of UBC's Founding members, Marion C Coody, Sr., age 87, went to his heavenly home on September 11, 2023.

He was preceded in death by his parents, L.H. Coody, Sr., Mary Elizabeth Selby Coody; a brother, Leslie Coody, Jr.; and a nephew, Greg Coody.

Marion, "Bubba or Coot" as he was known, was born on September 23, 1935, in Yazoo City, MS.

Bubba was an Eagle Scout, and a member of the football and track team at Yazoo High School. After graduating from MS State, he served four years in the U.S. Air Force as a Captain. He then took a job with NASA in Houston, Texas as a Project Engineer working on the Apollo, Mercury, and Space Shuttle/Station missions until he retired in 2002.
